What else has BCCI been working on?

Here is some of the other stuff we had going on in the last month:

- The first required by Bylaws term expiration and election of Board members was held on January 13th. Four of the five original Board members choose to run again. They are April Sansom, Bill Sisak, Mark Zuzanek and Bob Heinonen. All four were elected.
- The election of officers was held. The following were elected:
 - President is April Sansom
 - Vice President is Bill Sisak
 - Treasurer is Mark Zuzanek
 - Secretary is open with President responsible
- The transfer of duties from Bob Heinonen to other Board members has begun. Bob is retiring this coming March 2nd
- The BCCI Board has decided to hold another strategic planning session.
- The **BCCI Blanco County Landowner Outreach** project is working with a few landowners who are considering turning their property into a conservation easement. Data on land ownership in Blanco County has now been accumulated through research.
